




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## Red light district amsterdam pictures

De Wallen is just one of three Amsterdam neighbourhoods where everyday life is driven by sex. It is a place known as Amsterdam's Red Light district around the world. It has about 400 windows and is the center of all activities when we talk about this profession. A few centuries ago, almost every ship passing through the city crossed the canal of this district. Some long gone times in the Netherlands are remembered for their severe poverty. The poor offered their wives money and a few herrings. Herring in a roll along with garlic and olive oil remains a favorite fast food in Netherlands even nowadays. Herring is not heat-treated, but served raw and filleted. There is a lot of history going on around this district. One of them says that during the times of the highest prohibitions, the ladies recorded their testimony on a piece of file every night after their changes had been completed and put it at the door of the church located in that very district. The priests of Oude Kerk closed every morning, over and over again, every written confession with wax and forgave their sins in an act of indulgence. The church was against hustling, but not against the people. And what was at least the opposite is money. Today, right next to De Oude Kerk stands a statue of Belle, dedicated to all the ladies of the world. Much effort is being put into removing the stigma of the oldest profession in the world. The most commendable are the PIC (Prostitution Information Centre) and the Proud Union. Hustling is a harsh word, maybe... Prostitution? no, hustling sounds better. The word comes from Sanskrit and is associated with Kama Sutra. This means uncontrollable desire. Prostitution sounds a bit chilly, and to paraphrase, it means pushing forward. Hustling was therefore always part of Amsterdam's life. Often prohibited in the past, but never ceased to exist. He just moved to spaces where he was less visible. It was legalized from 1811, but with the prohibition of brothels, which made work much more difficult. Since 2000, it has also been legalized and regulated. If you ask the ladies, they will tell you that it is much detached from the hands of pimps and criminals, that it is much safer, organized and healthier for them. As for this profession, there is one thing forbidden, and it offers services on the street itself. Hence the even greater popularization of the so-called Raamprostitutie or hustling window. One ordinary day among the windows Not much is open here during the day. There is rent for the window during the day and it is much cheaper than the night. About 80 euros. If the girls do not work, the bars are. Old Sailor is a popular place to start. It is perfectly positioned when it comes to observing De Wallen's daily life. Across the street, one of the rare ladies involved in the day shift is strutting her breasts, cigarette in hand. She's looking for have a chitchat with passers-by. As she approached the window, she ate pizza and talked on the phone. Wtf with pizza, it's a carb-bomb! Then she signed to a neighbor, an older grandmother. She waves back at her with a smile and a few words in Dutch. We don't even know if she paid the daily rent or not, she's very picky. After all, the ladies decide for themselves when and for how long they will work. You can approach the ladies in many ways, but there is one that will make them ballistic. It's shooting. It's not uncommon to see them screaming in the street, pouring water on those who tried to take selfies right next to them, or even maybe from another side of the channel. These are the ones that eventually get the middle finger. De Wallen by day is an ordinary Quart of Amsterdam with a population of about 9,000 people. Typical 14th-century Dutch architecture. Tenants go grocery shopping, sit on the porch drinking wine and engage in conversations with part-time neighbors. Our friend Deltia expressed it best: Everything is normal here. The only thing left is for you, the people, to process it and accept it. It didn't take us long. Nightlife in this part of Amsterdam Neon colors have their own specific meaning. Red is for ladies. Blue is for everyone else. It is difficult to find a man outside the window, while there are many transsexuals. When the night falls, the first shy mother-in-law appear from all over the stone canal of Amsterdam. These are guys who like to come before others so they can go unnoticed. Mostly teenagers and Chinese. Everything is expensive for the Chinese. He didn't even come in, the lady didn't have a chance to pull even half the curtain out the window, and yet she gets thrown out. 50 euros for 15 minutes is apparently too much for him. In the words of a lady named Caja van Troile, who speaks very openly about her experiences with people, a fifteen-minute lounging is offered only to those mother-in-law who smell decent and look properly showered. Otherwise, the lady may request that the guy wash a little, which would mean that lounging can take more than 15 minutes. This practice is especially evident in Utrecht, because all window apartments have bathrooms. Caja van Troile says her every meeting starts in the shower. It is true that not everyone adheres to these rules. For some, the smell is fine. Every night the same party, all over again. Everything is crowded with people until the morning hours. De Wallen's window rental fee is now 150 euros, and there are waiting lists for most of them. You can get a discount if someone books it a few days in advance. The central location when it comes to rental issues is Office 52, which is the main insert between ladies and window owners. A whole week costs about 700 euros. Caja van Troile says she's back in happier times when taxes don't go up to 70%, you can repay all your rent within two to three days. Everything else is pure earnings. Maybe she complains for no reason. Statistics say that the average monthly salary is from 5,000 to 10,000 euros. Gross, though. At night, you can often come across professional crews offering shootings for ladies who paid little compared to the amount earned in the porn industry. And that's pretty fine for some of them. Most ladies come to work on a bike and will leave about 6, also on a bike. The windows are closed from 6 to 8 am, when, according to Dutch regulations, hygienic arrangements are made. Security De Wallen is said to be the safest place in the world after the Vatican. Police regularly patrol the area. Each window has its own cover. Ladies are never alone. If several windows have the same common space at the back, the guards are the misfortune to hear one of them trigger. This is similar to the sound of an alarm that is heard when a store is burgled in movies. In truth, the alarm goes out rarely. And when it does, it's not just one guard quickly jumping and rushing to help. Who are the ladies behind the windows? Only 25% of the ladies come from the Netherlands. The rest come from all over the world. Near De Oude Kerk there is a Spanish corner where only Latin American women are located. Other nations don't stick together that much. The law is very strict. A woman can not be under the age of 21 years. The change should not be longer than 11 hours. They must have a copy of their ID card with them at all times, together with registration with the Dutch BRA (Business Registers Agency) and a certificate of residence. There are not many ladies who care about formalities themselves. Most of them employ an accountant to organize bills, taxes and fees. Sounds like too much bureaucracy for hustling? That's the way it is. Being a lady is entrepreneurship. If you are at the very beginning of your career, PIC organizes all kinds of training. For ladies, this is a kind of startup. Peculiar attention is paid to the owners of shop windows in order to eliminate human trafficking and pimping. PIC claims that all the grotesque that accompany hustling are reduced to the lowest possible level since the profession was legalized. What you like the most is the question of health. HIV and drug use are reduced to statistical error. Healthcare and regular check-up scans are available to all. Fifty percent of ladies behind windows divorce women. Only 6% of them said they did it because they loved sex and excitement. Most ladies often see this as an opportunity to get good earnings. There are more than a few of those who do it for a living because they just don't have other means to work. It is a question of documents and legal residence in the Netherlands. And physically? From 150 to 210 cm. From 40 to 100 kilograms. From natural to plastic. Even those in costumes, most often in the uniforms of police officers and nurses. How crazy hustling can get is just the beginning of the story here. Everything that could be invented, related to sex, can be found in the district of De Wallen. Some places have become legendary for their performances that go beyond the limits of the norm. We do not refer to the Live Sex Show, which can be seen in the Moulin Rouge or Casa Rosso, but to the mobid performances of strippers who are able to put almost everything in or out of their crotch... such as dancing around a bar with lit candles sticking out of butts. This is a milder example of some ideas that cross their minds. Moulin Rouge is cheaper than Casa Rosso. Here's a hint for you: buy tickets that don't include drinks, it's cheaper when you order separately at the club. It's not just about gender. Performances are often comical. After all, the idea is to entertain people, not shock them. And sex and comedy go side by side phenomenally, especially when on stage there is an embarrassed Chinese man, with a stripper, take off his glasses from his head with his breasts. Another legendary place of De Wallen is the Banana Bar. The entry is 50 euros and during the time spent there you can drink as much as you want. This place has become legendary for naked ladies with a banana in hand, waiting for your signal so they can show you all the tricks they know. Each trick is paid extra and you are enrolled in the game. The biggest conundrum in the Peep Show, because you never know what you're doing inside the cabin. It is perfectly possible to pay 2 euros for 5 minutes peep, and end up watching a lady lifting her nose, getting her nails done, or wiggling her groin. But that's not the end of it. Condom shop where they learn to properly measure penis, erotica museums, Hash Marijuana & Hemp Museum, Prostitution Information Center, oldest ladies - 74-year-old twins with over 50 years of career, fetish clothes and props at Absolut Denny, The Hanky Panky School of Prostitution ... The struggle for support and understanding. This story was based on the information provided by them. Lord, therefore. The reason is simple. Even in the Netherlands alone, the stigma is very strong, although 70% of people say that there is no problem with this profession. There are even religious leagues fighting hustling. The government is not very sympathetic to them and the change frequently. It is not true that this profession is fully accepted. It is true that the government was smart enough to understand how drugs, sexually transmitted diseases and human trafficking can be more effectively controlled if society accepts. And they did it! At all costs, the Netherlands, which has windows in every third city and cafes in every sixth, is a country with one of the lowest crime rates in the world. Those who have something negative to say about hustling should talk to their mother-in-law because they are the reason why they exist.
